Represents shares of restricted stock granted to the Reporting Person on October 8, 1996 and October 23, 1997 under the Issuer's Long Term Stock Incentive Plan as follows: (i) 2,987 shares which may vest on October 8, 2001, (ii) 1,772 shares which may vest over a five-year period, and (iii) 8,962 shares which may be earned for the five-year performance period ending December 31, 2001 subject to the achievement of performance goals, 50% of which may be distributed when earned and 50% of which may be distributed over a five-year period commencing on the date earned.
- 3. Represents amounts allocated to, and the total holdings in, the Reporting Person's Company Stock Fund Account in the Company's Supplemental Savings and Investment Plan as of March 31, 2001, expressed as share equivalents. Because the trustee and record keeper for this plan utilize unit accounting for the Company Stock Fund rather than share accounting, these amounts represent share equivalents allocated to the Reporting Person's account rather than shares of Common Stock.
