On March 4, 2008, Greatbatch, Inc. (the "Company") issued a press release announcing the appointment of Dr. Helena S. Wisniewski to its Board of Directors (the "Board"). Her appointment was effective March 3, 2008. She also will serve on the Board's Corporate Governance and Nominating Committee as well as the Science & Technology Development Committee. Dr. Wisniewski's term as director will last until the next annual meeting of stockholders.

Dr. Wisniewski is Vice President, Research and Enterprise Development at the Stevens Institute of Technology, a position she has held since 2004. Prior to joining the Stevens Institute, Dr. Wisniewski was Chief Executive Officer and Chairman of Aurora Biometrics, a company she founded. Prior to that, Dr. Wisniewski was a senior executive at Lockheed Corporation and a Vice President of Titan Corporation. She also created and directed the first mathematics program at the Defense Advanced Research Projects Agency and held a key position at the CIA.

Dr. Wisniewski is Chairman of Attila Technologies, LLC, a company that provides continuous broadband on demand communication devices despite congested airways. She recently was appointed by the Secretary of the Navy to the Naval Research Advisory Committee. Dr. Wisniewski has received awards for her significant contributions to science, technology and leadership, and has patents pending in areas including biometrics, a field in which she has played key roles in development and commercialization since 1987.
