Issued pursuant to the Popular, Inc. 2004 Omnibus Incentive Plan consistent with the requirements of the TARP Interim Final Rule. The shares will vest on the second anniversary of the grant date. In order to be transferable, the Corporation must have achieved profitability for at least one fiscal year. Once the profitability condition is obtained, the restricted stock will be transferable in 25% increments in accordance with the Corporation's repayment of the TARP funds.
