BRASKEM PLACES US\$500 MILLION NOTE ISSUE

São Paulo, May 30, 2008 - Braskem (BOVESPA: BRKM3, BRKM5, BRKM6; NYSE: BAK; LATIBEX: XBRK), the leading company in the thermoplastic resins industry in Latin America and third-largest resin producer in the Americas, announces the placement of US\$500 million of its 7.250% Notes due 2018, priced at 99.127% of the principal amount which results in a yield to maturity of 7.375%.

According to Carlos Fadigas, Vice-President of Finance and Investor Relations at Braskem, with the issuance of these notes, Braskem will amortize a significant portion of the bridge loan contracted to acquire the petrochemical assets of the Ipiranga Group.
