Item 1.01 Entry Into a Definitive Material Agreement.

On April 8, 2005, PDF Solutions, Inc. (the Company) entered into its standard form Indemnity Agreement with Kevin MacLean, the Company s newly appointed Vice President, General Manager of DFM Solutions. The agreement requires the Company to indemnify Mr. MacLean against any liabilities that may arise by reason of his status or service as an officer of the Company other than for liabilities arising from willful misconduct of a culpable nature and to advance his expenses incurred as a result of any proceeding against him as to which he could be indemnified.
