**Item 1.01 Entry into a Material Definitive Agreement.**

On February 10, 2005, the Compensation Committee of the Board of Directors of Stoneridge, Inc. (the Company) approved the annual base salaries (for fiscal year 2005) of the Company's executive officers after a review of performance and competitive market data.
